

#9 Pickett's Charge



Connecticut troops were among the Union forces that met Pickett's Charge during the battle of Gettysburg.

The Connecticut 5th, 17th, 20th and 27th regiments – all with Stratford men in them – also fought at Gettysburg. Stephen Crofutt of the 17th (which had 16 men from Stratford in it) died on the field. The 14th suffered 66 casualties, over a third of the men engaged.

On May 5, 1864, the 14th was caught in the battle of the Wilderness where James Bartram was listed as missing. The regiment's last battle was at High Bridge, on the Appomattox River, on April 7, 1865.
