#28 Field Repairs

The Siegfried Line was a series of fortifications (including the "dragon's teeth" shown in the diorama) marking the German frontier.

Although, severely outgunned and underarmored when compared to German and Russian tanks, the Sherman tank made up for these disadvantages

through sheer numbers. Easy to produce, maintain and to modify for specific jobs (such as the recovery vehicle shown here) the Shermans greatly outnumbered their German enemies.
