

For Service in Iraq

The Iraq Campaign Medal (ICM) is a military award of the United States Armed Forces which was created by Executive Order 13363 of U.S. President George W. Bush on 29 November 2004 and became available for general distribution in June 2005.[4] The medal was awarded during the Iraq War, from 19 March 2003 to 31 December 2011. One side depicts a map of Iraq with two lines representing the Tigris and Euphrates rivers. On the reverse, the Statue of Freedom surmounts a sunburst, encircled by two scimitars pointing down with the blades crossing at the tips. The stripes of the ribbon invoke the colors of the Iraqi flag.
