From historic landmarks to one-of-a-kind museums, Stratford is rich with hidden gems!

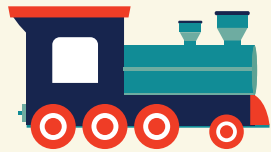
### BOOTHE MEMORIAL PARK & MUSEUM

The welcoming grounds of this 32-acre estate, listed on the National Register of Historic Places and bequeathed to the Town of Stratford by the Boothe Brothers in the late 1940's, invites visitors to step back in time with tours of unique buildings housing artifacts from the family's eccentric collections. The treasured Rose Garden\* is a highlight of any visit.

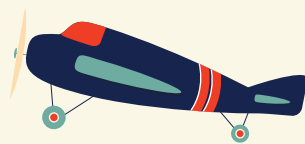
### BOOTHE MEMORIAL RAILWAY SOCIETY

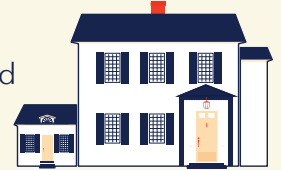
### STRATFORD HISTORICAL SOCIETY

### RUBY & CALVIN FLETCHER AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY MUSEUM

The exhibit is a collection of artifacts which reflect decades of turbulent times for African Americans in the United States during the period of slavery and the Civil Rights Movement. It brings visitors up close and personal which is an experience that many have only read about in history books or seen in movies.

### STRATFORD VETERANS MUSEUM

The Stratford Veterans Museum's mission is to recognize those veterans from Stratford who have served honorably in war and in peace and to act as a repository for their pictures and their history of service.

### PUTNEY CHAPEL MEETING HOUSE

This Historic Meeting House, located on the grounds of Boothe Park, was established in 1844 and continues to serve the community today by providing space for meetings, weddings, funerals, musical events, and many other family and civic gatherings.
