CAITLIN

Sgt. Caitlin McCormick served 4 years as a Management Infrastructure (KMI) Manager along side the explosives ordinance disposal platoon in Combat Logistics Battalion 13. She served 2 deployments to the Middle East including Native Fury in the United Arab Emirates in 2020 and Operation Allies Refugee in Afganistan in 2021. Sgt. McCormick was awarded two Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals and two Certificates of Commendation for her service overseas.

DANIEL

Sgt. Daniel McCormick served August 2016 to August 2023 as a Motor Transportation Mechanic. He participated in a Unit Deployment Program in Okinawa, Japan in 2017-2018 and MMRF-D in Darwin, Australia in 2022-2023. He was awarded the Navy and Marine Corps Achievment Medal, the Good Conduct Medal 2nd Award, the National Defense Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Medal and the Navy and Marine Corps Deployment ribbon 2nd Award.

EDWARD

HMC Edward J. McCormick served 22 years in the Navy as a Medical Corpsman and Instructor from 1951 to 1973. He served in the Koren War with the Mobile Construction Battalion 1 (MCB1) in Cuba, Puerto Rico and Operation Deep Freeze 2 (1956) at the South Pole, independent duty on the USS John R. Pierce DD753, as a Disaster Recover Training Instructor in Davisville, RI. and a Naval Air Maintenance Training Division Instructor in Jacksonville, FL. He received Letters of Commendation and Appreciation, five Good Conduct Medals, the National Defense medal, a Purple Heart Medal, Korean War Combat Ribbon with 2 stars, the Syngman Rhee Presidential Unit Citation, the United States Presidential Unit Citation and the Antarctic Expedition Medal.
